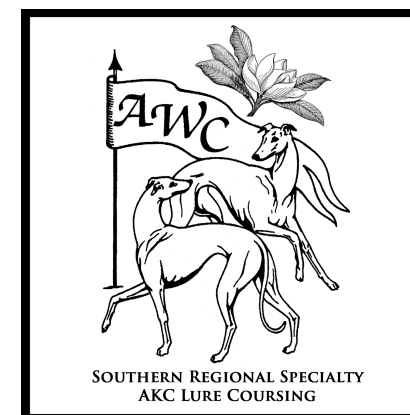

Stakes Offered

AKC REGULAR STAKES:

OPEN: Open to all whippets that have attained at least one of the following: AKC Qualified Courser Title, CKC Field Champion Title, ASFA FCh Title. Championship points may be awarded from this stake. Whippets who have earned an AKC Field Championship are not eligible to enter Open.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to all whippets, which are eligible to enter either Open or Special Stake, and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Championship or LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SPECIAL: Open to all whippets that are eligible to enter the Open stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SINGLES STAKE:

Singles: Will be offered. Open to all whippets. Whippets with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter.

ADDITIONAL STAKES:

Kennel Stake: For two whippets, designated at the time of entry, entered in one of the regular stakes, owned and kenneled by the same person.

Breeders Stake: For two whippets, designated at the time of entry, entered in one of the regular stakes bred by the same individual. The person entering this stake shall be the breeder.

Generation Stake: Each entry in this stake shall consist of a stud dog OR a brood bitch and one dog produced by that dog. Both dogs must be entered in a regular stakes, but need not be owned or bred by the same person. *Each Stud Dog or Brood Bitch can only be paired with one chosen offspring, however an offspring can be paired with either one or both parents.*

Note: An Owner/Breeder may have more than one entry in the Kennel/Breeder/Generation Stakes as long as the two whippets comprising each entry are properly identified at the time of entry. A whippet may only be part of any one Kennel or Breeder Stake entry. See above for rules involving the Generation Stake pairings. Please send in Breeder/Kennel/Generation Stake forms indicating pairs along with properly marked entry forms.

High Scoring Dual Champion Stake: For the whippets that have both an AKC Conformation Championship and an AKC Field Championship title. An award will be awarded both Saturday and Sunday. Please send in High Scoring Dual Championship form along with fees.

There will be no JC/QC Tests during this event. If interested, enter the MAHA AKC Lure coursing trial - same day and location.

Only pre-entries are accepted.

Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

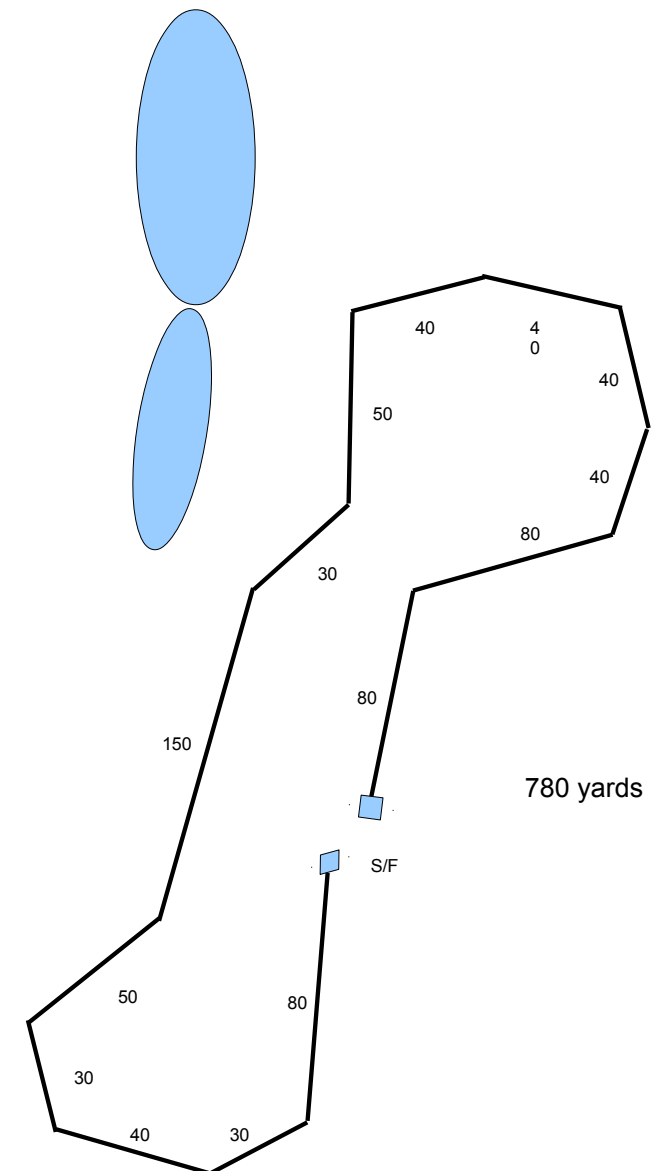

The field will be reversed for the finals, runoffs, and Best of Breed.

PRACTICE

Will be held Friday and Saturday, if weather, equipment and daylight permit.
Practice is \$3 per dog/run. Priority will be given to sighthound breeds.

Practice will NOT be offered on Sunday.

1. AWC & MAHA club members and all exhibitors will follow **State** and **local** guidelines.
2. All Field Committee and Lure Operators will wear facial coverings. All participants will wear facial coverings. The club will not provide facial coverings.
3. No food will be served, bring your own breakfast, lunch and dinner. Please bring your own food, water and shade for yourself and your dogs.
4. We ask that you park at a safe distance away from each other.
5. Roll Call will be done at everyone's car, instead of a central location. The roll call committee will wear facial coverings. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.

8. Huntmasters will stand 6 feet from the dogs after inspecting blankets and slip leads.

10. Practice social distancing the best you can; especially around the FTS table, giving them space to work.
11. We ask that exhibitors approach the score sheets one person at a time and maintain social distance guidelines.
12. No self-serve ribbons anymore due to cross contamination.
13. **These trials will be pre-entry only. Payments by Pay-Pal ONLY!** If your dog QC's one of the days and you would like to enter them in the trials, let the FTS know and pay via PayPal. **Checks and cash will not be accepted day-of.**
14. **We will not be accepting any day-of entries or payments for entries, practice runs or anything. If any payments need to be made, a PayPal to awcsouthernregionLC@gmail.com will be accepted.**
15. Exhibitors who refuse to comply when reasonably asked to follow mask, sanitary or social distancing guidelines will be removed from the property.
