

How to enter your dog and earn AKC Titles in LC

- * **FIRST** - you want to start by practicing your dog alone to make sure they will follow the lure and have good interest; then move to practicing with other dogs (this is to make sure they are not interfering either aggressively OR playfully) - Practice is offered on Saturday after the trial is finished. Times may vary.
- * **NEXT** - if your dog has practiced successfully with other dogs (not interfering either aggressively OR playfully), you can enter him in the QC TEST. Your dog must first pass a **Qualifying Courser (QC)** certification test before they can compete with other hounds.
- * To Enter the QC TEST, you are required to **fill out an Entry form** and be sure to CHECK OFF "QC" near the TOP of THE ENTRY FORM - *Remember to bring a filled out copy of the **"Qualified Courser Certificate"** at the end of this Premium list. The Judge must sign this form when you dog passes the test. A copy of this certificate must be submitted with the trial results the first time entry in the open stake. So submit that form to the FTS at their first trial.
- * **NEXT-** if your dog has earned a QC TITLE and you feel like they have practiced enough with other dogs, you can enter them in **Open Stake** and work towards the Senior Courser (SC) title. If your dog also places high enough, he will earn points towards his Field Championship title. (See Rule book for point schedule.)
- * To enter in the Open Stake: CHECK "OPEN" ON THE ENTRY FORM, **BRING A COPY OF THE QC CERTIFICATE** AND PAY THE ENTRY FEE FOR OPEN. There is no additional fee for the SC leg. To earn the SC title, the hound must run with at least one other hound, and must receive qualifying scores at FOUR (4) AKC trials under two different judges or judging panels.
- * When your dog has earned the SC title, he most likely will still be competing for Field Championship points. If he receives qualifying scores in 25 trials, he will earn the Master Courser (MC) title.
- * The title of **Field Champion (FC)** is a prefix to a hound's name. It is earned by obtaining 15 points from the Open or Veteran stakes. Dog must win 2 first placements worth 3 or more points under two different judges or judging panels (majors).
- * **FINALLY!** If your dog has earned his Field Championship title, they must now be entered in the **Special Stake**. They are no longer eligible to enter the open stake. However they can continue on to work towards an LCX title and an MC title!

Trial Hours: 7:00 AM until complete - [Day of Trial Entries close at 7:15AM](#)

Trial Roll Call: 7:30 AM for JC/QC Test - 7:45 AM for ALL Hounds, early Roll for Field Committee, followed by draw. If a hound passes the required QC Test and the owner/handler wishes to enter the subsequent trial, the AKC Coursing Director has granted this club permission to accept trial entries following the test. Entries in this case will be accepted for a period of 15 minutes immediately following the announced finish of the QC Test.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS and REGISTRY

Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzois, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis and Whippets that are one year of age or older, that have been registered with The American Kennel Club, or part of an AKC-registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the United States of America and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry, or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Qualified Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser.

Those sighthounds enrolled in AKC's FSS and which are eligible to compete in Conformation Miscellaneous class (Norrbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portugese Podengos (Medino and Grande) and Thai Ridgebacks) are eligible to compete in lure coursing tests and trials and will be awarded the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Qualified Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser only.

Spayed or neutered hounds are eligible to participate. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Hounds may not be entered as "registration or ILP pending". Breed disqualifications apply. Dogs with Limited Registration are eligible to participate.

Portugese Podengos Pequenos and FSS breeds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.

RUNNING PROCEDURES

- 1: Stakes will be split by random draw if the entry in any one stake is sufficient to hold two or more five point majors.
- 2: All Hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications.
- 3: Altered or neutered hounds may compete. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are NOT eligible to compete.
- 4: Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused. Entry fees for hounds excused during inspection will be refunded if notified by the time roll call closes. No substitutions can be made at that time.
- 5: Hounds not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period, and entry fees will NOT be refunded.
- 6: Electrical-powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used with back-up equipment available.
- 7: The lure will consist of plastic contrasting in color with the immediate field environment
- 8: Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled.

TERMS OF ENTRY

- 9: Children must be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times.
10: Only an official photographer will be allowed onto the fields if one is present.
11: There will be no photography or recording of any type during the roll call procedures at these trials. There will be no filming or recording of individuals or their hounds at these trials without explicit permission from them. Individuals failing to follow these terms will be escorted off the premises, no warnings will be offered and no refunds will be given.
12: Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC, MAHA, and/or any Hound(s) or other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site, no refunds will be given.
13: MAHA and the Shadow Hill Training Center assume no liability for injury to any person or dog, or damage or loss of any personal property before, during or after these trials.
14: There will be a \$5 fine for any loose hound on the field that is not part of the course in progress.
15: A fee of \$25 will be assessed for any returned check.
16: Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Anyone found not cleaning up after their dog will be fined \$25. **DO NOT put dog feces in the toilets!**
17: All funds should be paid in US currency. NO foreign currency will be accepted
18. **By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to compete safely. By signing your entry you agree to all the terms above, as well as following the rules of AKC and MAHA.**

STAKES OFFERED

AKC JC and QC TESTS - offered both days - first event of the day

The **JUNIOR COURSER TEST** is open to all hounds of an eligible breed at least 1 year of age. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed at least a 600 yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

The **QUALIFIED COURSER TEST** is open to all hounds of an eligible breed at least 1 year of age. A hound (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.

The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. Upon successful completion of the Qualified Courser test, the judge completes a certificate and awards it to the handler.

This certificate must be submitted to the host club with the hound's first entry in an Open Stake. The certificate must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC.

AKC REGULAR STAKES:

OPEN: Open to all hounds that have attained at least one of the following: AKC Qualified Courser Title, CKC Field Champion Title, ASFA FCh Title. Championship points may be awarded from this stake. Hounds who have earned an AKC Field Championship are not eligible to enter Open.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to all hounds, which are eligible to enter either Open or Special Stake, and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Championship or LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SPECIAL: Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter the Open stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SINGLES STAKE:

Singles: Will be offered both days. Open to all hounds 1 year or older. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter.

Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

BIF will be offered both days

RIBBONS and PRIZES

First - Blue, Second - Red, Third - Yellow, Fourth - White, Fifth - Pink Best of Breed - Purple and Gold

Best in Field - Red, White and Blue

Junior Courser/Qualifying Courser - Green

All Ribbons and prizes, unless otherwise said, are donated by MAHA

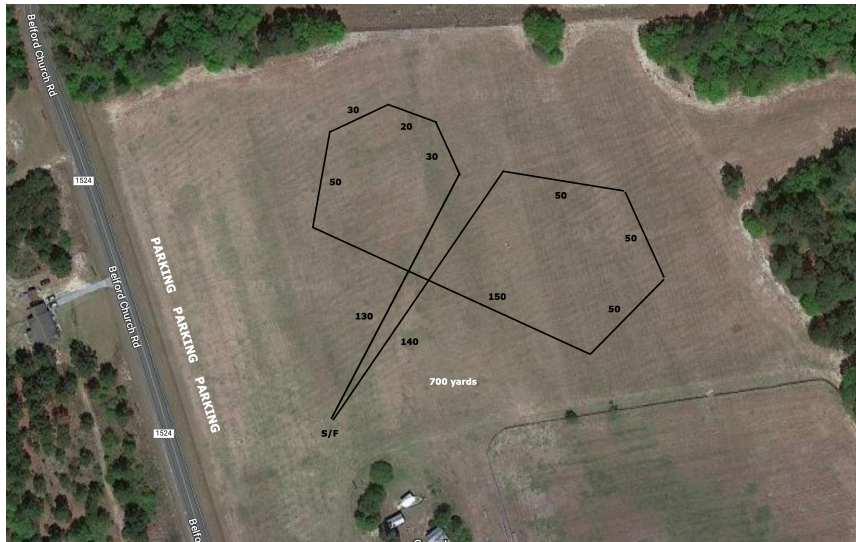
FIELD

Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of plastic strips. The members of the AWC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial. The field will be reversed for the finals, runoffs, Best of Breed, Best In Field.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL

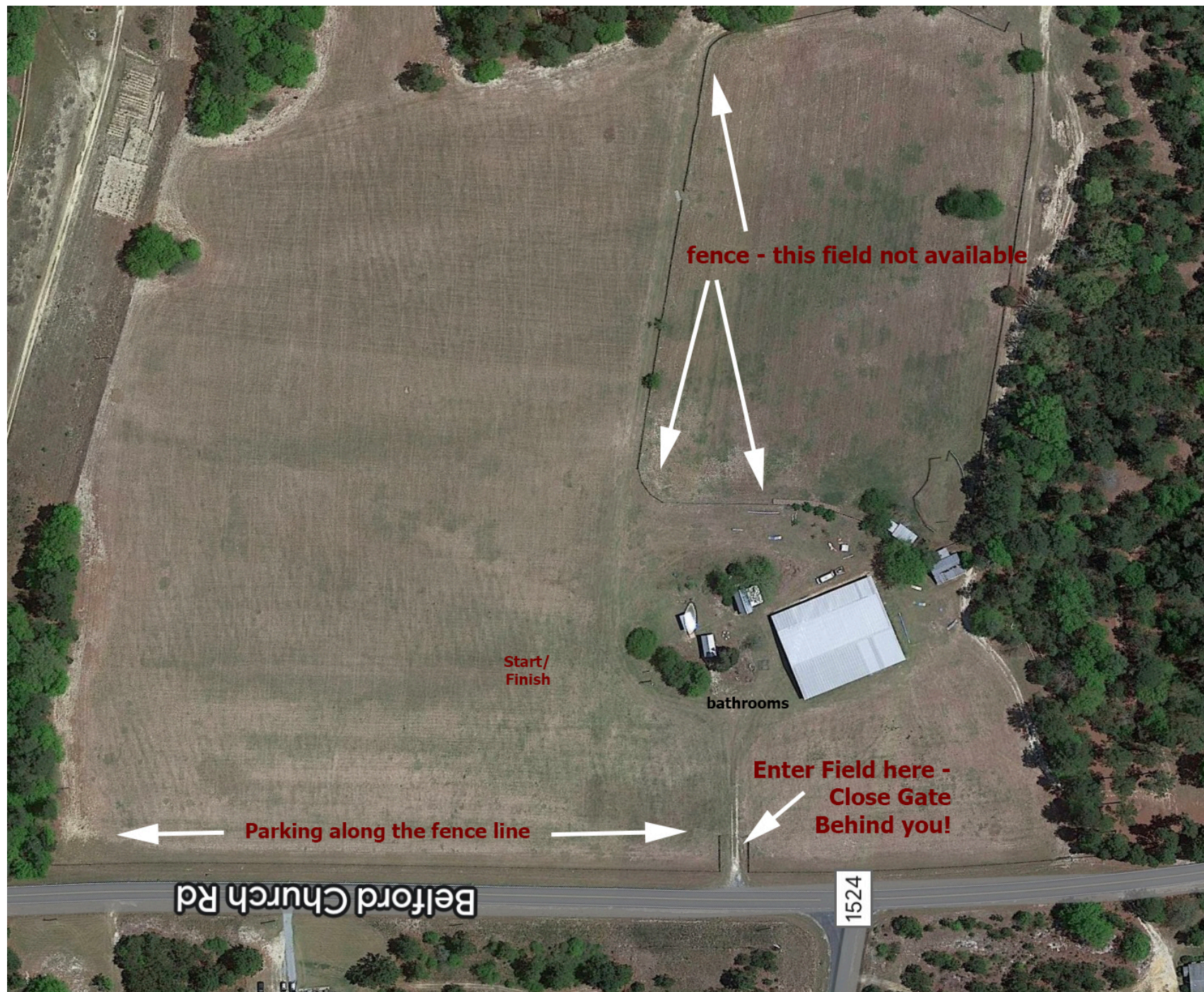

If coming from the East - make your way to NC 73 and turn WEST onto Jackson Springs Rd. After 1.6 miles the road name changes to Belford Church Rd. The field is 1.1 miles on the RIGHT. ** The field is slightly past the GPS Location.

MAHA is excited to announce the use of a New Field for our November 2023 trials! As always, please treat this field with respect and make sure to keep it clean.

1. IF you enter/leave and the gate was closed, Please close it behind you. We will leave the gate open for an hour prior to roll call when we expect everyone to arrive, otherwise it should be closed.

2. Please pick up all dog feces and DON'T but the feces in the human toilets!!!!
3. Please park along the fence line to the left of the entrance OR park in the area in front of the building.
4. The building will be open and available for anyone to use if the weather is not pleasant. You are welcome to set up crates in there if needed/desired.
